We are powering the future

Wascana Solar Co-operative was formed by a group of individuals who wanted to help accelerate the deployment of clean, affordable, and secure electricity in their communities. Southern Saskatchewan is in the sweet spot for solar energy, with over 300 days per year of sunshine. This free energy can be captured with increasingly affordable solar panels and converted into electricity that can be used on-site or returned to the grid, substantially reducing power bills.

We were incorporated in 2018 with the mission to “Sustainably build, invest in, own and operate solar power generation projects in Regina and across Saskatchewan through a cooperative community model; and to create a better understanding of solar power through education and advocacy.” We aim to accelerate Regina towards cost-effective residential and commercial solar energy solutions.

Wascana Solar Co-op has two programs for its members:

SOLAR INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

We facilitate community investment in renewable energy by selling shares to members. We then use the funds generated by these sales to finance, build and own solar projects in Regina and Southern Saskatchewan. Revenues are distributed to shareholders as dividends. Solar Investment Opportunity installations are on large buildings, usually owned by a business, community-based organization or public agency.

SOLAR WAY PROGRAM:

We help our members (individuals or organizations) install solar arrays on their homes, garages, or businesses by facilitating every stage of the process, with lower costs and shorter timelines. To cover costs and generate revenue for the Co-op, we levy a small surcharge on the cost of an installation if the member chooses to go ahead.

As of January 2026, we have 162 members in Regina and area. Our members have invested nearly \$200,000 to power our community with solar energy, and the results speak for themselves:

- We've generated 312,043 kWh and counting through our Solar Investment Opportunities project.
- We've facilitated the installation of 989 solar panels for 45 individual property owners through our Solar Way Program, for a total system size of 358 kW.



- We recently installed a new array of 32 solar panels on the roof of one of Regina's YWCA buildings, and are currently selling shares to fund our next big installation.
